- The committee will not be looking at using a technical writer for the report development, but will use one for a final proofing.
- Consider FERC Order 1000
  - o Biennial Report
    - Included in the body of the report will be mention of FERC's Order 1000 and the potential impact on how this will affect NTTG's Cost Allocation Committee in the future.
    - The development of a potential default cost allocation methodology will not be addressed as a current activity as it is not developed enough to produce a draft for public viewing. Also, it will most likely be subsumed in the work/response FERC Order 1000 and therefore current work on the default cost allocation methodology initiative is on hold.
  - o General initial thoughts on FERC Order 1000
    - Per the Order the region must develop a cost allocation methodology that results in choosing what type of benefits will be evaluated and also outline the process for evaluation.
    - The Order allows regions pick what projects are included in the plan and considered for cost allocation.
    - The Order allows flexibility for bilateral agreements that can look different than agreements within same region. The inter-region agreement appears it will facilitate a project by project system, whereas the same region looks more at a class of projects approach.
    - There is some concern that the flexibility upon deciding which projects would have cost allocation or not might provide an opportunity for potential manipulation within the system.
    - The guidelines on distinction between cost allocation and cost recovery are not clear in the Order, especially when involving more than one transmission provider.
    - There is opportunity for NTTG to be a leader in the area and can develop a clearer methodology that can be proposed by NTTG as a subregion.
    - It is agreed that NTTG is in a position to lead the clarification on topics within the Order.
