Northern Tier Transmission Group Stakeholders:

On April 24, 2019, the NTTG Planning Committee approved the Quarter 5 Regional Economic Study Request (ESR) for NTTG to study an alternative transmission configuration to replace the 500 kV Gateway West and South projects with one or two 345 kV lines between Windstar-Aeolus area to Populus-Borah-Midpoint area. The NTTG Technical Workgroup has subsequently prepared a draft study plan for this analysis and it is posted for public stakeholder review and comment.
