



**Northern Tier Transmission Group (NTTG)
Procedure for Required Disclosure of
Critical Energy Infrastructure Information (CEII)**

NTTG coordinates the individual transmission systems operations, products, business practices, and planning of their high-voltage transmission network to meet and improve transmission services that deliver power to consumers. All the data used in the various studies conducted on behalf of NTTG resides with either the NTTG Transmission Providers or the Western Electricity Coordinating Council (WECC).

A party desiring transmission-related information from NTTG that is considered CEII or of a confidential nature will request that data from the appropriate NTTG Transmission Provider. The party will follow the procedures of that Transmission Provider. In the event the data resides at WECC, the party will follow the WECC process for obtaining that data.

Requests for CEII made to state regulatory members of NTTG in connection with NTTG business will be referred to the appropriate NTTG Transmission Provider or to WECC as necessary.

Any modifications done to power flow cases or the WECC economic congestion database will be noted in the appropriate NTTG study reports.
